Connectbase Software Release Notes

New features and enhancements in this release

Connectbase introduced the following new features, enhancements and bug fixes in this release.

TCW Enhancements

Added a new {QUOTE_COUNTRIES_ISO3} Placeholder to the Activity Approvals Email Template

This enhancement makes the placeholder {QUOTE_COUNTRIES_ISO3} available for the CPQ Activity Approval email template in either the subject line or body. For customers quoting internationally this improves the ability to route work internally.

The placeholder dynamically fetches and displays a comma-separated list of all ISO3 country codes (e.g., USA,ARG,GBR,FRA) in the alphabetic order associated with the selected quote solutions that are being sent for approval in the respective approval request.

SA API - Enabled Address Alias Validation

We now support address alias validation by referencing internal market data, allowing users to entering a building or data center name (e.g., "Equinix AM1") instead of a full street address. For an alias to be recognized, it must first be added by our Data team to the system's market data location database. Once stored, address validation process will resolve the alias to the full address, streamlining the search experience and reducing the need for exact address inputs.

API Endpoint Domain Change
